## Sparkling

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### Galanti Prosecco

## Red

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175ml / 250ml / Bottle

### Esporao Alandra Tinto, Alentejo

£4.40 / £6.20 / £18.50

This fruit driven wine, employs the same grapes used in port production, so expect fresh berry aromas, soft tannins and a subtle on the finish with no oak ageing.

### Passo Sardo Vino Rosso, Isola dei Nuragi

£4.70 / £6.80 / £20.00

A heady mixture of ripe red and black fruits with a pinch of spice, coming from a blend of Grenache, Carignan and Graciano grapes sourced from vineyards right across the island of Sardinia.

### Pablo Old Vine Garnacha

£5.70 / £7.40 / £22.00

Garnacha has been the mainstay of wine production in the mountainous Calatayud region for hundreds of years. The grapes for this richly flavoured wine were hand-harvested from old vines, many of which are about a 100-years-old. Shows ripe blueberry, blackberry and cherry fruit, backed by a refreshing juicy finish.

### Cairanne Côtes du Rhône Villages,

Dauvergne Ranvier

From the village of Cairanne in the heart of the Côtes du Rhône region. Here, in the sun-drenched hills, Grenache and Syrah ripen in vineyards to produce this dark and brooding wine with ripe red and black hedgerow fruit, balancing acidity and fine tannins.

### Errazuriz Pinot Noir,

Casablanca

Vibrant cherry and strawberry jam fruit character on the nose, with notes of fraise and frambois on the tastebuds. Hand-harvested and aged in French oak, this is elegant and smooth.

### Atamisque Serbal Malbec,

Tupungato, Mendoza

£32

Intense ruby-red, the nose shows aromas of red fruit and violet; the palate shows plenty of that same red fruit, namely wild raspberry and strawberry with splashes of plum and damson flavours, finishing fresh and juicy. This is a very well cared after wine utilising gravity flow production throughout the winery which allows the gentlest treatment of grapes and juice. Unoaked, the wine is afforded an extended ageing period prior to release.

### Chateaufeuf du Pape,

Bois de Pied Redal, Organic, Ogier

£40

The vineyard of Pied Redalis cultivated without any weed-killers or pesticides and certified organic. The blend is mainly Grenache, with Syrah, Mourvèdre and Cinsault. Shows dark fruit flavours, such as black cherry and blackcurrant, spiced with liquorice and aromatic herbs; the palate is full-bodied with fine-grained tannins which give it a smooth finish. An exceptional example of this French classic.

## White

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175ml / 250ml / Bottle

### Vine Trail Gewurtztraminer, Curico Valley

£4.50 / £6.80 / £18.00

A dry Gewürztraminer, with just a touch of richness; well-balanced showing classic notes of orange blossom, lychee and rose followed by a fresh finish.

### Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico, Filaretto

£4.70 / £6.80 / £20

Made from Verdicchio grapes grown close to the famous town of Jesi in the Marche region. Very elegant, soft, fresh style with a hint of hazelnut on the finish. Presented in the classic traditional bottle.

### Quinta dos Murcas Assobio Branco, Duoro

£5.40 / £7.80 / £23.00

This blend varies every year, but utilises Verdelho, Gouveio, Viosinho, Rabigato and Códaga do Larinho varietals. The grapes are harvested by hand and the fermentation is carried out at low temperatures developing a wine with a fresh, aromatic nature. Lime citrus and a touch of passionfruit on the nose and vibrant and lively on the palate.

### Vol d'Anima de Raimat Blanco Costers del Segre, Raimat

£25.00

Pale yellow with greenish highlights; yellow fruit such as peach and nectarine on the nose, together with pear and melon and aromas of white flowers and Mediterranean aromatic herbs. Unoaked, the palate is fresh and well-structured, with plenty of fruit flavours and a zesty finish. The 2014 vintage was judged the Best Great Value White at the Wines from Spain Awards 2015.

### Te Awa Left Field Sauv. Blanc, Nelson

£28.00

An absolute southern hemisphere ripper! A blend of 91% Sauvignon Blanc from Nelson and 9% from Waipara further south on the South Island. Strongly aromatic with a touch of richness, a crisp vibrancy and aromas of passion fruit, nectarine and lemongrass alongside other green herbs.

### Paco & Lola Albarino Rias Baixas

£33.00

Attractive straw colour with hints of green in the rim; expressive and harmonious nose of green apples, pear and lemons, with hints of herbs and flower blossom base notes. The palate is clean and textured with seductive exotic notes of pineapple and mango intermingled with refreshing citrus flavours amplified by mineral accents.

### Chablis, Vignerons de Chablis

£40.00

Fresh, lively with a citrus and white blossom character backed by a finish tinged with minerality. The Chardonnay grapes are harvested at the optimum moment, usually quite late due to Chablis' cool-climate, and cool fermented in stainless steel prior to a period of rest and integration before bottling.

## Rosé

### Provence Rosé

Beautifully pale pink rosé bursting with strawberry and raspberry fruit accompanying subtle flavours of watermelon and nectarine.
